## JUSTICES REGULATION 1993

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 28 March 1995]

### PART 1—PRELIMINARY

#### Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Justices Regulation 1993*.

#### Definitions

2. In this regulation—

“**nominated law**” means a law specified in schedule 1 as a law for infringement notice offences.

“**registrar**” has the meaning given by the *Magistrates Courts Act 1921*.

“**table**”, for a nominated law, means the table of infringement notice offences and penalties set out in schedule 1 for the law.

### PART 2—INFRINGEMENT NOTICE NOTICES

#### Infringement notice offences and penalties (nominated laws)

- 3.(1) For part 4A of the Act<sup>1</sup>—

- (a) an offence against a provision of a nominated law specified in the table, column 1 for the law is an offence (an “**infringement notice offence**”) to which the part applies; and
- (b) the amount specified in the table, column 2 set out opposite the infringement notice offence is the penalty (the “**infringement**”

**notice penalty”)** payable for the offence under an infringement notice.

(2) In some cases of a nominated law, for example, the *Traffic Regulation 1962*, a description of an offence is also given in the table, column 1 and the infringement notice offence for subsection (1) is the offence against the provision as described in column 1.

(3) Subsection (1) and schedule 1 (as far as they relate to the following nominated laws) expire 18 months after they commence—

- *Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Act 1984*
- *Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulation 1989*
- *State Transport Act 1960*
- *State Transport Regulation 1987*
- *Tow Truck Act 1973*
- *Tow Truck Regulation 1988*
- *Traffic Act 1949*
- *Traffic Regulation 1962*
- *Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Act 1991*
- *Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Regulation 1991.*

#### **Administering authority (nominated laws)**

4.(1) The administering authority for an infringement notice and an infringement notice offence for a nominated law is the chief executive of the department dealing with the provisions of the law.

(2) However, the administering authority for an infringement notice and an infringement notice offence for a nominated law in schedule 2, column 1 is the person specified in schedule 2, column 2 for the law.

#### **Authorised person for infringement notice (nominated laws)**

5. The person authorised to serve an infringement notice under



section 98C of the Act<sup>2</sup> for an infringement notice offence for a nominated law is the person specified in schedule 1 for the law.

**Authorised person for nominated laws for reminder notice, enforcement notice and withdrawal from acting under pt 4A, div 3 of Act<sup>3</sup>**

**6.(1)** The person authorised to—

- (a) serve a reminder notice; and
- (b) give an enforcement order; and
- (c) withdraw from acting under part 4A, division 3 of the Act;

for an infringement notice offence for a nominated law is the chief executive of the department dealing with the provisions of the law.

**(2)** However, the person authorised to—

- (a) serve a reminder notice; and
- (b) give an enforcement order; and
- (c) withdraw from acting under part 4A, division 3 of the Act;

for an infringement notice offence for a nominated law mentioned in schedule 2, column 1 (other than the *Motor Accident Insurance Act 1994*) is the person mentioned in schedule 2, column 2 for the law.

**(3)** The person authorised to—

- (a) serve a reminder notice; and
- (b) give an enforcement order; and
- (c) withdraw from acting under part 4A, division 3 of the Act;

for an infringement notice offence for the *Motor Accident Insurance Act 1994* is the chief executive of the department in which the *Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Act 1991* is administered.

**Act prescribed as a registration Act**

7. For the definition “registration Act” in section 98B of the Act,<sup>4</sup> the *Motor Vehicles Safety Act 1980* is a registration Act.

**Identifying particulars for alleged offender**

8. The identifying particulars under section 98C(3)(b)(ii) of the Act for an alleged offender are the following—

- (a) colour of hair and eyes;
- (b) complexion;
- (c) height;
- (d) build;
- (e) other noticeable distinguishing marks or features.

**Identifying particulars for vehicle**

9.(1) The identifying particulars for a vehicle under section 98C(3)(e) of the Act are the following—

- (a) registration number;
- (b) body type;
- (c) registration label number and its expiry date;
- (d) make;
- (e) colour;
- (f) other noticeable distinguishing marks or characteristics;
- (g) if relevant to the offence—the number of passengers in the vehicle.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply if other identifying particulars for a vehicle under section 98C(3)(e) of the Act are stated in schedule 1 for a nominated law.

**Identifying particulars for an infringement notice offence for a railway law**

**10.(1)** In this section—

“**railway law**” means—

- (a) the *Transport Infrastructure (Railways) Act 1991*; or
- (b) the *Transport Infrastructure (Railways) Regulation 1994*.

**(2)** The identifying particulars under section 98C(3)(d)(ii) of the Act for an alleged offence that—

- (a) is an infringement notice offence mentioned in schedule 1 for a railway law; and
- (b) happened during a journey on a railway;

are the approximate times and stations between which the offence was committed on the journey.

**Identifying particulars for animal**

**11.** The identifying particulars for an animal under section 98C(3)(f) of the Act are the following—

- (a) kind and species;
- (b) colour;
- (c) distinguishing marks, brands or other features.

**Period of imprisonment**

**12.** The prescribed period of imprisonment under section 98P(1)(b)(i)(A) of the Act<sup>5</sup> for an infringement notice offence is twice the number of days worked out under section 98P(1)(b)(i)(B) of the Act.

**Prescribed court—Act, s 98P(2)(a)**

**13.** The prescribed court under section 98P(2)(a) of the Act is the

## **PART 3—GENERAL**

### **Places for holding Magistrates Courts**

**14.** A place mentioned in schedule 4, column 2 is appointed as a place for holding Magistrates Courts within the district, and, for Brisbane, the division (if any), mentioned opposite in schedule 4, column 1.

### **Fees**

**15.** The fees payable under part 4A of the Act are set out in schedule 3.

### **Forms**

**16.(1)** The chief executive may approve forms for the purposes of the Act.

**(2)** A person may ask a registrar for a document setting out an approved form.

**(3)** A registrar must promptly comply with a request under subsection (2).

## **PART 4—FURTHER TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS FOR SETONS**

### **Relevant law**

**17.** Each of the following laws is a relevant law—

- *Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Act 1984*
- *Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulation 1989*

- *State Transport Act 1960*
- *State Transport Regulation 1987*
- *Tow Truck Act 1973*
- *Tow Truck Regulation 1988*
- *Traffic Act 1949*
- *Traffic Regulation 1962*
- *Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Act 1991*
- *Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Regulation 1991.*

### **Notice that is an infringement notice**

**18.** A notice that is given, issued or served under any of the following relevant laws is an infringement notice—

- *Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulation 1989*, section 32<sup>6</sup>
- *State Transport Regulation 1987*, section 94A<sup>7</sup>
- *Tow Truck Regulation 1988*, section 50<sup>8</sup>
- *Traffic Regulation 1962*, section 140<sup>9</sup>
- *Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Regulation 1991*, section 4.32.<sup>10</sup>

### **Expiry of part**

**19.** This part expires when section 270 of the Act<sup>11</sup> expires.

## **PART 5—TRANSITIONAL**

### **Transitional**

**21.(1)** Despite section 20, the *Justices (Offence Notices) Regulation 1992* continues to apply to an infringement notice mentioned in section 269 of the Act.<sup>12</sup>

**(2)** This part expires when section 269 of the Act expires.
