JUSTICES REGULATION 1993

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 4 June 1998]

PART 1—PRELIMINARY

Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Justices Regulation 1993*.

Dictionary

2. The dictionary¹ in schedule 6 defines particular words used in this regulation.

PART 1A—COMPUTER WARRANTS

Prescribed warrants—Act, s 66(4)

2A. For section 66(4) of the Act,² the following types of warrant are prescribed—

- (a) a warrant issued under the *Bail Act 1980*;
- (b) a warrant of commitment and warrant of execution issued under the *Justices Act 1886*;
- (c) a warrant of commitment issued under the *Penalties and Sentences Act 1992*.

Approved procedures for computer warrants—Act, s 67(1)(b)

2B. For section 67(1)(b) of the Act,³ the following procedures for computer stored information are approved—

- (a) procedures made by the chief executive and stated in the departmental document titled ‘Computer Warrant Procedures’;⁴
- (b) procedures made by the commissioner of the police service and stated in the Department of Police document titled ‘Operational Procedures Manual’, section 13.20.⁵

Prescribed information—Act, s 69B(2)

2C. A document made under the approved procedures and used to execute a computer warrant must include—

- (a) the following information about the warrant—
 - (i) type;
 - (ii) reference number;
 - (iii) date of issue;
 - (iv) issuing entity’s name and location;
 - (v) Act under which it was issued;
 - (vi) for a warrant of commitment for failure to pay an amount—
 - (A) amount payable; and
 - (B) default period of imprisonment;
 - (vii) for a warrant of execution—the amount payable; and
- (b) the following information about the person to whom the warrant

relates—

- (i) name;
 - (ii) address stated on the warrant;
 - (iii) latest known address; and
- (c) the following information about the offence or alleged offence in relation to which the warrant was issued—
- (i) description of the offence or alleged offence;
 - (ii) provision of the Act or statutory instrument that was contravened or allegedly contravened;
 - (iii) date of the offence or alleged offence;
 - (iv) place where the offence or alleged offence happened.

Certification of a document made under the approved procedures and used to execute a computer warrant or written warrant—Act, ss 69B(5)(b) and 69E(4)(b)

2D.(1) For section 69B(5)(b) of the Act,⁶ if anyone is arrested on execution of a computer warrant using a document made under the approved procedures, the document is to be certified by the arresting officer.

(2) For section 69E(4)(b) of the Act,⁷ if anyone is arrested on execution of a written warrant using a prescribed document,⁸ the prescribed document is to be certified by the arresting officer.

Prescribed document—Act, s 69E(1)(b)

2E. The document titled ‘Warrant work list’, made under the approved procedures and used to execute a written warrant is prescribed for section 69E(1)(b) of the Act.⁹

PART 2—INFRINGEMENT NOTICES

Division 1—Nominated laws

Infringement notice offences and penalties (nominated laws)

3.(1) For part 4A¹⁰ of the Act—

- (a) an offence against a provision of a nominated law specified in the table, column 1 for the law is an offence (an **“infringement notice offence”**) to which the part applies; and
- (b) the amount specified in the table, column 2 set out opposite the infringement notice offence is the penalty (the **“infringement notice penalty”**) payable for the offence under an infringement notice.

(2) In some cases of a nominated law, for example, the *Traffic Regulation 1962*, a description of an offence is also given in the table, column 1 and the infringement notice offence for subsection (1) is the offence against the provision as described in column 1.

Administering authority (nominated laws)

4.(1) The administering authority for an infringement notice and an infringement notice offence for a nominated law is the chief executive of the department dealing with the provisions of the law.

(2) However, the administering authority for an infringement notice and an infringement notice offence is—

- (a) for a nominated law in schedule 2, column 1—the person specified in schedule 2, column 2 for the law; or
- (b) for the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*¹¹—
 - (i) if the infringement notice is served by an employee of a local

government—the local government’s chief executive officer;
or

- (ii) otherwise—the chief executive of the department in which that Act is administered.

Authorised person for infringement notice (nominated laws)

5. The person authorised to serve an infringement notice under section 98C¹² of the Act for an infringement notice offence for a nominated law is the person specified in schedule 1 for the law.

Authorised person for nominated laws for reminder notice, enforcement notice and withdrawal from acting under the Act, pt 4A, div 3

6.(1) In this section—

“authorised person” means the person authorised to—

- (a) serve a reminder notice; and
- (b) give an enforcement notice; and
- (c) withdraw from acting under part 4A, division 3¹³ of the Act.

(2) The authorised person for an infringement notice offence is—

- (a) for the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*—an authorised person appointed under section 128¹⁴ of that Act; or
- (b) for the *Motor Accident Insurance Act 1994*—the chief executive of the department in which the *Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Act 1991* is administered; or
- (c) for a nominated law mentioned in schedule 2, column 1 (other than the *Motor Accident Insurance Act 1994*)—the person mentioned in schedule 2, column 2 for the law; or

- (d) for any other nominated law—the chief executive of the department in which the law is administered.

Division 2—Local laws and regulated parking

Infringement notice offences and penalties (local laws and regulated parking)

6A.(1) For part 4A of the Act—

- (a) subject to subsection (2), the following are offences (“**infringement notice offences**”) to which the part applies—
- (i) an offence against a local law;
 - (ii) an offence in relation to regulated parking for which a local government has prescribed an amount under section 44F(5) of the *Traffic Act 1949*;¹⁵ and
- (b) the penalty (“**infringement notice penalty**”) payable for an infringement notice offence under an infringement notice is—
- (i) for an offence mentioned in paragraph (a)(i)—the amount worked out under schedule 1A for the offence; or
 - (ii) for an offence mentioned in paragraph (a)(ii)—the amount prescribed by the local government for the offence under the *Traffic Act 1949*, section 44F(5).

(2) This division applies to an offence in relation to regulated parking only if the infringement notice is served by an authorised officer under section 6C.

Administering authority (local laws and regulated parking)

6B. The administering authority for an infringement notice and an infringement notice offence mentioned in section 6A(1)(a) is the chief executive officer of the local government that made the local law or prescribed the amount.

Authorised person for infringement notice (local laws and regulated parking)

6C. The person authorised to serve an infringement notice under section 98C¹⁶ of the Act for an infringement notice offence mentioned in section 6A(1)(a) is an authorised person under the *Local Government Act 1993*, section 676.¹⁷

Authorised person for local laws and regulated parking for reminder notice, enforcement notice and withdrawal from acting under the Act, pt 4A, div 3

6D. The person authorised to—

- (a) serve a reminder notice; and
- (b) give an enforcement notice; and
- (c) withdraw from acting under part 4A, division 3¹⁸ of the Act;

for an infringement notice offence mentioned in section 6A(1)(a) is the chief executive officer of the local government that made the local law or prescribed the amount.

Division 3—Miscellaneous**Act prescribed as a registration Act**

7. For the definition “registration Act” in section 98B¹⁹ of the Act, the *Motor Vehicles Safety Act 1980* is a registration Act.

Identifying particulars for alleged offender

8.(1) The identifying particulars under section 98C(3)(b)(ii) of the Act for an alleged offender are the following—

- (a) colour of hair and eyes;
- (b) complexion;
- (c) height;
- (d) build;
- (e) other noticeable distinguishing marks or features.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a camera-detected offence under the *Traffic Act 1949*.

Identifying particulars for vehicle

9.(1) The identifying particulars for a vehicle under section 98C(3)(e) of the Act are the following—

- (a) registration number;
- (b) body type;
- (c) registration label number and its month and year;
- (d) make;
- (e) colour;
- (f) other noticeable distinguishing marks or characteristics;
- (g) if relevant to the offence—the number of passengers in the vehicle.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply if other identifying particulars for a vehicle under section 98C(3)(e) of the Act are stated in schedule 1 for a nominated law.

(3) For a camera-detected offence under the *Traffic Act 1949*, subsection (1)(c) to (e) does not apply if it is not practicable to ascertain those particulars from the image taken by the camera.

Identifying particulars for an infringement notice offence for a railway law

10.(1) In this section—

“**railway law**” means—

- (a) the *Transport Infrastructure (Railways) Act 1991*; or
- (b) the *Transport Infrastructure (Railways) Regulation 1994*.

(2) The identifying particulars under section 98C(3)(d)(ii) of the Act for an alleged offence that—

- (a) is an infringement notice offence mentioned in schedule 1 for a railway law; and

‘**14.(1)** This section applies to each charge of an offence for which a proceeding may be brought under the Act if the defendant is—

- (a) arrested on the charge, with or without a warrant; or
- (b) served with a notice to appear under the *Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 1997*.

‘**(2)** However, this section does not apply to a charge of an offence if another Act requires a bench charge sheet for the charge to be prepared.⁷⁸

‘**(3)** A police officer must give a bench charge sheet for each charge of an offence to the clerk of the court before which the defendant is brought.

‘**(4)** The bench charge sheet must state the names of the defendant and of the complainant.

‘**(5)** The bench charge sheet must also state the offence with which the person is charged in a way, and with whichever of the following particulars, that may be necessary to inform the defendant of the nature of the charge—

- (a) particulars of the alleged time and place of committing the offence;
- (b) particulars of the person (if any) alleged to be aggrieved;
- (c) particulars of the property (if any) in question.

‘**(6)** Any circumstances of aggravation on which it is intended to rely must be stated in the bench charge sheet.

‘**(7)** It is sufficient to describe an offence in the words of the Criminal Code or the statute defining it, or in similar words.

‘**(8)** A description of persons or things that would be sufficient in an indictment is sufficient in a bench charge sheet.⁷⁹

- (b) the nature of the complaint or application;
- (c) any plea of the defendant (whether accepted, or entered, by the court);
- (d) the court's decision on the charge or application.
