Magistrates Regulation 2003

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 11 December 2009]

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Magistrates Regulation 2003*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2003.

3 Form of oath or affirmation for magistrates—Act, s 9(1)

- (1) For the purpose of section 9(1) of the Act, the oath is as follows—

‘I, _____, swear that I will properly serve Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Her Heirs and Successors, in the office of magistrate and that I will treat everyone fairly and without bias according to law—SO HELP ME GOD!’.

- (2) For the purpose of section 9(1) of the Act, the affirmation is as follows—

‘I, _____, solemnly affirm that I will properly serve Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Her Heirs and Successors, in the office of magistrate and that I will treat everyone fairly and without bias according to law.’.

4 Form of oath or affirmation for judicial registrars—Act, s 53F(1)

- (1) For the purpose of section 53F(1) of the Act, the oath is as follows—

‘I, _____, swear that I will properly serve Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Her Heirs and Successors, in the

office of judicial registrar and that I will treat everyone fairly and without bias according to law—SO HELP ME GOD!’.

- (2) For the purpose of section 53F(1) of the Act, the affirmation is as follows—

‘I, _____, solemnly affirm that I will properly serve Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Her Heirs and Successors, in the office of judicial registrar and that I will treat everyone fairly and without bias according to law.’.

5 Expiry of pt 9A—Act, s 53S(2)

The period before expiry of part 9A of the Act under section 53S(1) of the Act is extended by 1 year.

Part 9A now expires on 1 January 2011.
