Land Court Regulation 2000

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 15 April 2010]

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Land Court Regulation 2000*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 July 2000.

3 Fees

The fees payable under the Act are stated in the schedule.

4 Preservation of rights of relevant officer appointed as acting member—Act, s 19(4)

- (1) This section applies to the public service officer appointed as an acting member under section 19 of the Act on 15 April 2010 (the *relevant officer*).
- (2) The relevant officer keeps all rights that have accrued to the relevant officer because of employment as a public service officer, or that would accrue in the future to the relevant officer because of that employment, as if the relevant officer's service as an acting member were a continuation of the relevant officer's service as a public service officer.
- (3) At the end of the relevant officer's appointment as an acting member—
 - (a) the relevant officer is entitled to be appointed to an office in the public service at a salary level not less than the current salary level of an office equivalent to the office the relevant officer held before being appointed as an acting member; and

- (b) the relevant officer's service as an acting member is to be regarded as service in the public service for the purpose of deciding the relevant officer's rights as an officer of the public service.

Examples of rights—

long service, recreation and sick leave and rights as a member of a superannuation scheme.
