# Superannuation (State Public Sector) Regulation 2006

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 3 May 2013]

## 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Superannuation (State Public Sector) Regulation 2006*.

## 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 2 September 2006.

## 3 Units of the State public sector—Act, s 2(1)

Each of the entities mentioned in the schedule is declared to be a unit of the State public sector for section 2(1) of the Act, definition *unit of the State public sector*.

## 4 Eligible schemes—Act, s 2A

The Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation Fund, established under the *Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation Act 1970*, is declared to be an eligible scheme for the Act.

## 5 Prescribed number—Act, s 5

For section 5 of the Act, the prescribed number is 6.

## 6 Declared expressions—Act, s 21(4)

The following expressions, associated with the scheme, are declared to be expressions to which the Act, section 21, applies—

- (a) QSuper;
