1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Personal Property Securities (Ancillary Provisions) Regulation 2011*.

2 Commencement

- (1) Section 3 and the schedule, part 1 commence immediately after the commencement of the Act, chapter 3, part 1.
- (2) Section 4 and the schedule, part 2 commence immediately after the commencement of the Act, chapter 3, part 3.
- (3) Section 5 and the schedule, part 3 commence immediately after the commencement of the Act, chapter 3, part 4.

3 Fees—Act, s 17(2)

For the Act, section 17(2), the fees payable are stated in the schedule, part 1.

4 Fees—Act, s 40(2)

For the Act, section 40(2), the fees payable are stated in the schedule, part 2.
