**An Act to Amend "The Diseases in Stock Acts, 1915 to 1935," in certain particulars.**

[ASSENTED TO 12TH NOVEMBER, 1936.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title  
and  
construction.

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Diseases in Stock Acts Amendment Act of 1936*," and shall be read as one with \*"*The Diseases in Stock Acts, 1915 to 1935*," hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act.

The Principal Act and this Act may collectively be cited as "*The Diseases in Stock Acts, 1915 to 1936*."

Amendment  
of s. 18.

2. Section eighteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended, as follows:—

(a) The second paragraph of the said section, being the paragraph commencing with the words "Provided that" and ending with the words "destination is intended," is repealed and the following new paragraph is inserted in lieu thereof, namely:—

"Provided that a permit to travel shall be issued for the travelling of stock only where the inspector is satisfied that the application for the permit to travel is made by the *bona fide* owner of such stock or his authorised agent and where, in the opinion of the inspector, a *bona fide* destination is intended."

(b) The following new paragraph is added to the said section, namely:—

"No person other than an inspector shall make any alteration in or endorsement on a permit to travel stock."

3. Subsection one of section twenty-eight of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion therein, after paragraph (h), of the following new paragraphs, namely:—

Amendment  
of s. 28.

- “(i) Not being an inspector, makes any alteration in or endorsement on a permit to travel stock ;
- (j) Travels, or attempts to travel, or is in any way concerned in travelling, stock under the authority of a permit containing any alteration or endorsement which has not been made by an inspector, unless in any such case such person proves that he had no knowledge of the act that the permit concerned contained any such alteration or endorsement,”

and by renumbering the existing paragraph (i) thereof (k) accordingly.
