**An Act to Amend "The Oaths Acts, 1867 to 1959," in certain particulars.**

[ASSENTED TO 31ST OCTOBER, 1960.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "*The Oaths Acts Amendment Act of 1960.*"

Principal Act.

(2.) "*The Oaths Acts, 1867 to 1959,*" are in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Collective title.

(3.) The Principal Act and this Act may be collectively cited as "*The Oaths Acts, 1867 to 1960.*"

**2. Section thirteen of the Principal Act is amended—**

Amendment  
of s. 13.

(a) by omitting the marginal note to that section and inserting in its stead the marginal note "Persons entitled to take declarations"; and

(b) by inserting after the words "or other officer now by law authorised to administer an oath" the words "or any barrister, solicitor or conveyancer of the Supreme Court."
