An Act to Amend "The Health Acts, 1937 to 1959," in certain particulars.

[ASSENTED TO 30TH DECEMBER, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "*The Health Acts* Short title.
Amendment Act of 1960."

(2.) "*The Health Acts, 1937 to 1959,*" are in this Principal Act.
Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act and this Act may be Collective title.
collectively cited as "*The Health Acts, 1937 to 1960.*"

2. Subsection one of section one hundred and fifty-two of the Principal Act is amended by, in the proviso to paragraph (i.), repealing the words "Brandy, not more than twenty-five degrees under proof" and inserting in lieu of those repealed words, the words "Brandy, not more than thirty-five degrees under proof".
