**EQUITY AND FAIR TRADING LEGISLATION
AMENDMENT REGULATION (No. 1) 2000**

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Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Equity and Fair Trading Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2000*.

Commencement

2.(1) Section 3, other than to the extent it provides for the amendment of the *Business Names Regulation 1998*, commences on 1 July 2000.

(2) Section 3, to the extent it provides for the amendment of the *Business Names Regulation 1998* commences on 1 August 2000.
