1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Weapons Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2002*.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Weapons Regulation 1996*.

3 Amendment of s 39 (Construction of premises where collection stored)

Section 39(2)—

omit, insert—

‘(2) However, a person need not comply with subsection (1) if—

- (a) for a category H weapon made permanently inoperable, the way the weapon is stored complies with section 60(3) and (4); or
- (b) for a weapon other than a category H weapon—
 - (i) there are no more than 30 weapons at the premises where the weapon is; and
 - (ii) the way the weapon is stored complies with section 60(2) to (4).’.

4 Amendment of sch 2 (Government service entities and prescribed functions for them and their employees for the Act’s non-application)

(1) Schedule 2, section 4, heading, ‘**Authority**’—

omit, insert—

‘**Service**’.

(2) Schedule 2, section 4(1), ‘Authority’—

omit, insert—

‘Service’.

(3) Schedule 2, section 4(1), “**QFRA**” —

omit, insert—

“QFRS”.

(4) Schedule 2, section 4(2), ‘QFRA’s’—

omit, insert—

‘QFRS’s’.

(5) Schedule 2, section 4(3), ‘QFRA’—

omit, insert—

‘QFRS’.
