1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Civil Liability (Postponement) Regulation 2004*.

2 Postponed commencement of Act, ch 2, pt 2

(1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 9 April 2005.¹

(2) In this section—

“**postponed law**” means the Act, chapter 2, part 2.²

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 11 April 2005.
