1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Amendment Regulation (No. 2) 2007*.

2 Commencement

- (1) Section 4 commences on 30 April 2007.
- (2) Section 5 commences on 4 May 2007.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2004*.

4 Insertion of new pt 6, div 5A

After section 168—

insert—

‘Division 5A Particular provisions about restricted licences and licence disqualifications

‘168A Application for variation of restrictions—Act, s 202K

‘For section 202K(4) of the Act, a written notice about an application must be—

- (a) in the approved form; and
- (b) given to the chief executive at the address stated in the approved form as the address for giving the notice.

‘168B Notice about application for removal of disqualification—Act, s 202L

‘For section 202L(4) of the Act, a written notice about an application must be—

- (a) in the approved form; and

- (b) given to the chief executive at the address stated in the approved form as the address for giving the notice.’.

5 Amendment of sch 10 (Fees, charges and related matters)

Schedule 10—

insert—

‘30 Electronic search to verify person is holder of licence

‘For section 205B(1) of the Act, the fee is \$5.00.’.
