1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Land Protection (Pest and Stock Route Management) Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2007*.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Land Protection (Pest and Stock Route Management) Regulation 2003*.

3 Amendment of s 6 (Building lines for declared pest fences—Act, s 47)

- (1) Section 6(1)(a), after ‘dingoes’—

insert—

‘and dogs other than domestic dogs’.

- (2) Section 6(1)(a)(i), ‘main dingo’—

omit, insert—

‘wild dog’.

- (3) Section 6(1)(a)(ii), ‘dingo’—

omit, insert—

‘wild dog’.

4 Amendment of s 8C (Prescribed education program)

Section 8C(2), after ‘pest animal’—

insert—

‘, other than a European rabbit (domestic breeds only),’.

5 Amendment of sch 2 (Class 1 pest plants, and class 2 and 3 pests)

- (1) Schedule 2, section 1, entries for acacias, myrica, piper, thunbergia and willow—

omit.

(2) Schedule 2, section 1—

insert—

- acacias non-indigenous to Australia (*Acacia* spp. (syn. *Vachellia* spp.) other than *Acacia nilotica*, *Acacia albizioides* (syn. *Senegalia albizioides*), *Acacia bidwillii* (syn. *Vachellia bidwillii*), *Acacia clarksoniana* (syn. *Vachellia clarksoniana*), *Acacia ditricha* (syn. *Vachellia ditricha*), *Acacia douglasica* (syn. *Vachellia douglasica*), *Acacia pachyphloia* (syn. *Vachellia pachyphloia*), *Acacia pallidifolia* (syn. *Vachellia pallidifolia*), *Acacia suberosa* (syn. *Vachellia suberosa*), *Acacia sutherlandii* (syn. *Vachellia sutherlandii*), *Acacia valida* (syn. *Vachellia valida*), *Acaciella* spp., *Senegalia* spp. other than *Senegalia albizioides* and *Mariosousa* spp.)
- candleberry myrth (*Myrica faya*)
- cholla cactus (*Cylindropuntia* spp. and hybrids, other than *C. spinosior*, *C. fulgida* and *C. imbricata*)
- fanwort (*Cabomba* spp. other than *C. caroliniana*)
- harrisia cactus (*Harrisia* spp. syn. *Eriocereus* spp. other than *H. martinii*, *H. tortuosa* and *H. pomanensis* syn. *Cereus pomanensis*)
- Mexican bean tree (all *Cecropia* spp.)
- Mexican feather grass (*Nassella tenuissima*)
- spiked pepper (*Piper aduncum*)
- prickly pear (*Opuntia* spp. other than *O. ficus-indica*, *O. stricta*, *O. aurantiaca*, *O. monacantha*, *O. tomentosa* and *O. streptacantha*)
- thunbergias with the following names—
 - annual thunbergia (*Thunbergia annua*)
 - fragrant thunbergia (*T. fragrans*)
 - laurel clockvine (*T. laurifolia*)
- water mimosa (*Neptunia oleracea* and *N. plena*)

- willow (*Salix* spp. other than *S. babylonica*, *S. humboldtiana* (syn. *S. chilensis*), *S. matsudana*, *S. x calodendron* and *S. x reichardtii*).
- (3) Schedule 2, section 1, entry for kochia, ‘(*Kochia scoparia*)’—
omit, insert—
‘(*Bassia scoparia* syn. *Kochia scoparia*)’.
- (4) Schedule 2, section 1, entry for limnocharis, after ‘limnocharis’—
insert—
‘or yellow burrhead’.
- (5) Schedule 2, section 1, entry for Peruvian primrose, after ‘Peruvian primrose’—
insert—
‘bush’.
- (6) Schedule 2, section 3, entries for American rat’s tail grass, giant Parramatta grass, giant rat’s tail grass, harrisia cactus, mother of millions, Parramatta grass, prickly pear, sicklepods—
omit.
- (7) Schedule 2, section 3—
insert—
- cholla cacti with the following names—
 - coral cactus (*Cylindropuntia fulgida*)
 - devil’s rope pear (*C. imbricata*)
 - snake cactus (*C. spinosior*)
 - harrisia cactus (*Harrisia martinii* syn. *Eriocereus martinii*, *H. tortuosa* and *H. pomanensis* syn. *Cereus pomanensis*)
 - kudzu (*Pueraria montana* var. *lobata* syn. *Pueraria lobata*), other than in the Torres Strait Islands
 - mother of millions (*Bryophyllum delagoense* syn. *B. tubiflorum*, *Kalanchoe delagoensis*)

- mother of millions hybrid (*Bryophyllum* x *houghtonii* (syn. *B. daigremontianum* x *B. delagoense*, *Kalanchoe* x *houghtonii*))
 - prickly pears with the following names—
 - common pest pear, spiny pest pear (*O. stricta* syn. *O. inermis*)
 - drooping tree pear (*O. monacantha* syn. *O. vulgaris*)
 - tiger pear (*O. aurantiaca*)
 - velvety tree pear (*O. tomentosa*)
 - Westwood pear (*O. streptacantha*)
 - rat's tail grasses with the following names—
 - American rat's tail grass (*Sporobolus jacquemontii*)
 - giant Parramatta grass (*Sporobolus fertilis*)
 - giant rat's tail grass (*Sporobolus pyramidalis* and *S. natalensis*)
 - Parramatta grass (*Sporobolus africanus*)
 - sicklepods with the following names—
 - foetid cassia (*Senna tora*)
 - hairy cassia (*Senna hirsuta*)
 - sicklepod (*Senna obtusifolia*)
 - telegraph weed (*Heterotheca grandiflora*)'.
- (8) Schedule 2, section 3, entry for belly-ache bush, after 'gossypifolia'—
insert—
'and hybrids'.
- (9) Schedule 2, section 3, entry for cabomba, 'spp.'—
omit, insert—
'caroliniana'.

- (10) Schedule 2, section 3, entry for hymenachne, after ‘hymenachne’—
insert—
‘or Olive hymenachne’.
- (11) Schedule 2, section 3, entry for thunbergia, after ‘thunbergia’—
insert—
‘or blue thunbergia’.
- (12) Schedule 2, section 4, entries for captain cook tree, lantana, pencil willow, privets and tortured willow—
omit.
- (13) Schedule 2, section 4—
insert—
- Captain Cook tree or yellow oleander (*Cascabela thevetia* syn. *Thevetia peruviana*)
 - lantanas with the following names—
 - lantana or common lantana (*Lantana camara*)
 - creeping lantana (*L. montevidensis*)
 - privets with the following names—
 - broad-leaf privet or tree privet (*Ligustrum lucidum*)
 - small-leaf privet or Chinese privet (*L. sinense*)
 - willows with the following names—
 - pencil willow (*Salix humboldtiana* syn. *S. chilensis*)
 - tortured willow (*Salix matsudana*)’.
- (14) Schedule 2, section 4, entry for cat’s claw vine, ‘vine’—
omit, insert—
‘creeper’.
- (15) Schedule 2, section 4, entry for purple rubber vine, ‘purple’—

omit, insert—

‘ornamental’.

6 Amendment of sch 6 (Dictionary)

Schedule 6, definition *dingo*—

omit.
