1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Fisheries Amendment Regulation (No. 3) 2008*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 6 October 2008.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Fisheries Regulation 2008*.

4 Insertion of new ch 13, pt 4

After section 642—

insert—

‘Part 4 Other matters

‘642A Prescribed fishing apparatus—Act, s 14

‘(1) For section 14(3) of the Act, definition *prescribed fishing apparatus*, paragraph (b), a fish trap is a prescribed fishing apparatus.

‘(2) In this section—

fish trap means a structure made predominantly from stone or organic material that creates a holding area designed to capture a small quantity of fish.

‘642B Prescribed waters—Act, s 14

‘For section 14(3) of the Act, definition *prescribed waters*, paragraph (b), the following regulated waters are prescribed—

- Coombabah Lake and Coombabah Creek
- Swan Bay
- Wolf Rock (grey nurse shark protection area)

- Tinana Creek Barrage (downstream)
- Mary River Barrage (downstream)
- Burnett River Barrage (downstream)
- Kolan River Barrage (downstream)
- Keppel Bay (fishing)
- Fitzroy River Barrage (downstream)
- Hook Island (fishing)
- Yanks Jetty at Orpheus Island
- Centenary Lakes, Cairns
- Barron River (fishing)
- Bizant River, Princess Charlotte Bay.’.
