Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Nature Conservation Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 4) 2008*.

2 Main purpose of regulation

- (1) The main purpose of this regulation is to revoke the dedication of the whole of the forest reserves mentioned in section 4 to allow the forest reserve (each a *revoked forest reserve area*) to become a protected area.
- (2) Each revoked forest reserve area is dedicated as a protected area under part 3.
