(c) construction, maintenance and use of a water pipeline in the area shown as ‘Existing Easement–Water Pipeline’ on the plan titled ‘Great Sandy National Park Cooloola Coast water pipeline’.

(3) Schedule 3, entry for Wooroonaoran National Park—

omit, insert—

‘Wooroonaoran National Park—the following parts—

- (a) the part identified as ‘Proposed Transmission Line’ on plans A3–H–132537–03, A3–H–132537–04 and A3–H–132537–05; an electricity distribution use
- (b) the part that is 10m on each side of the overhead powerline route through lot 19 on NPW921, as shown on plan 2361–01 an electricity distribution use’.

12 Amendment of sch 4 (Permitted uses in national parks)

Schedule 4, entry for Pioneer Peaks National Park, column 1, ‘Country’—

omit, insert—

‘County’.
