Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Forestry and Nature Conservation Legislation Amendment Regulation (No. 3) 2009*.

2 Main purpose of regulation

- (1) The main purpose of this regulation is to revoke the dedication of—
 - (a) the whole of the forest reserves mentioned in section 6(1) to allow each forest reserve (a *revoked forest reserve area*) to become a protected area; and
 - (b) the parts of the forest reserves mentioned in section 6(3) to (7) to allow each part (also a *revoked forest reserve area*) to become a protected area.
- (2) Each revoked forest reserve area is dedicated as a protected area under part 4.

‘Imbil Forest Reserve 1 Lots 1 to 3 on AP19205 situated in the County of Lennox, containing an area of about 10ha’.

(6) Schedule, entry for Kenilworth Forest Reserve—

‘Kenilworth Forest Reserve Lot 1 on AP19206 situated in the County of Lennox, containing an area of about 24ha’.

(7) Schedule, entry for Nerang Forest Reserve—

omit, insert—

‘Nerang Forest Reserve Lot 1 on AP14652 situated in the County of Ward, containing an area of about 44.6ha’.

Nerang National Park	Lot 224 on plan NPW704 situated in the County of Ward, containing an area of about 1614.4ha’.

‘Clear Mountain Conservation Park	Lots 1662 and 1663 on plan NPW744 situated in the County of Stanley, containing an area of about 531ha
Conondale Conservation Park	Lot 571 on plan NPW747 situated in the County of Lennox, containing an area of about 1.24ha’.
