1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Criminal Proceeds Confiscation and Other Acts Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2010*.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

(1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 23 February 2011.

(2) In this section—

postponed law means the *Criminal Proceeds Confiscation and Other Acts Amendment Act 2009*, part 4 other than the following—

- section 70
- section 74(2) to the extent it inserts new section 21(1)(d) and (e) in the *Security Providers Act 1993*.

Editor's note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 24 February 2011.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 25 February 2011.
