1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Nature Conservation (Protected Areas Management) Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2013*.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Nature Conservation (Protected Areas Management) Regulation 2006*.

Mount Windsor National Park—the part identified as ‘Roadtek site’ on plan ‘Mount Windsor Tableland Radio Site’	a communications use

Noosa National Park—the parts identified as ‘Area A’ and ‘Area B’ in Lot 147 on NPW889	maintenance and use of water infrastructure
Tewantin National Park—the part identified as ‘Area A’ in Lot 959 on NPW1140	a communications use
Tuchekoi National Park—the part identified as ‘Area A’ in Lot 210 on NPW833	maintenance and use of water infrastructure
Woowoonga National Park—the part identified as ‘Cleared area’ on the map titled ‘Woowoonga National Park - telecommunications site’, containing an area of about 400m ²	a communications use

(2) Schedule 3, entry for Whitsunday Islands National Park—

(c) the part identified as ‘Mount Robinson Communication Tower’ on administrative plan CEN AP076, containing an area of about 266m ²	a marine navigation use

Molle Islands National Park—the parts identified on plan ‘South Molle Island Infrastructure on Lot A & B on HR1825’	maintenance and use of a water pipeline, water tanks, pumping station and sewage pipeline
