Agricultural Chemicals Distribution Control Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2013

Subordinate Legislation 2013 No. 232

Agricultural Chemicals Distribution Control Act 1966

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1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Agricultural Chemicals Distribution Control Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2013*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 22 November 2013.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Agricultural Chemicals Distribution Control Regulation 1998*.

4 Amendment of s 8A (Commercial operator's licence—relevant pest management qualification for pest management technician—Act, s 16A)

Section 8A(1)—

- (1) For section 16A(1) of the Act, a relevant pest management qualification is—
 - (a) a statement of attainment issued by a registered training organisation stating that an individual has successfully completed—
 - (i) each of the following competencies—
 - (A) CPPPMT3005—Modify environment to manage pests;
 - (B) CPPPMT3006—Apply pesticides to manage pests;
 - (C) CPPPMT3018—Maintain equipment and chemical storage areas; or
 - (ii) each of the following competencies—
 - (A) PRMPM05—Modify environment to manage pests;

- (B) PRMPM06—Apply pesticide to manage pests;
 - (C) PRMPM18—Maintain an equipment and consumables storage area; or
- (b) the successful completion of training that the chief executive reasonably considers is substantially equivalent to a statement of attainment mentioned in paragraph (a).
