**1 Short title**

This regulation may be cited as the *Industrial Relations Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2014*.

**2 Regulation amended**

This regulation amends the *Industrial Relations Regulation 2011*.

**3 Amendment of s 146A (Extension of nominal expiry date—Act, s 828)**

Section 146A—

(2) For section 828(2)(b) of the Act—

- (a) 31 December 2014 is prescribed for the ‘QBuild Field Staff Certified Agreement 8 (2011)’ as it applies to employees of City Parklands Transition Services Pty Ltd ACN 068 043 318; and
- (b) 31 December 2014 is prescribed for the ‘QBuild Office Staff Certified Agreement 8 (2009)’ as it applies to employees of City Parklands Transition Services Pty Ltd; and
- (c) 31 December 2014 is prescribed for the ‘South Bank Employing Office Employees’ Certified Agreement 2011’ as it applies to employees of City Parklands Transition Services Pty Ltd.
