1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *State Buildings Protective Security Amendment Regulation (No. 1) 2014*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 30 June 2014.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *State Buildings Protective Security Regulation 2008*.

3A Declaration of Legal Aid Queensland offices as state buildings—Act, s 4(4)

(1) For section 4(4) of the Act, the following are state buildings—

- (a) the buildings and their precincts located on the land described in schedule 1, part 2, item 1;

- (b) the part of the building, located on the land described in schedule 1, part 2, item 2, that is the subject of registered leases GA, GE and G2 under the *Land Title Act 1994* and the precincts of the building located on that land.

- (2) This section expires on 30 June 2017.
