1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Associations Incorporation and Other Legislation Amendment (Postponement) Regulation 2021*.

2 Postponed commencement of uncommenced provisions

(1) The period before automatic commencement, under the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 15DA(2), of the postponed law is extended to the end of 21 June 2022.

(2) In this section—

postponed law means the uncommenced provisions of the *Associations Incorporation and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2020*.

Editor's note—

The postponed law now automatically commences on 22 June 2022.

3 Expiry

This regulation expires on 23 June 2022.
