1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Police Service Administration Amendment Regulation 2024*.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Police Service Administration Regulation 2016*.

3 Insertion of new s 73

After section 72—

insert—

73 Transfer of surplus gifts, contributions or other money on revocation of endorsement as deductible gift recipient

- (1) This section applies if the service's endorsement as a deductible gift recipient under the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997* (Cwlth) is revoked under that Act.
- (2) The commissioner must, on behalf of the service, transfer to another entity that is endorsed as a deductible gift recipient under the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997* (Cwlth) and has similar purposes for which the service was endorsed as a deductible gift recipient any surplus gifts, contributions or other money mentioned in section 30-125(6)(b) of that Act.
