ERRATUM TO

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Title of the Bill

Child Protection Reform and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2021 (the Bill).

Reason for Erratum

On 15 September 2021, the Bill was introduced into Parliament. A mismatch between the Bill and the Explanatory Notes in regards to clauses 50 to 52 was subsequently identified, where:

- Clause 50 in the Bill relates to Clause 51 in the Explanatory Notes
- Clause 51 in the Bill relates to Clause 52 in the Explanatory Notes
- Clause 52 in the Bill relates to Clause 50 in the Explanatory Notes.

The Erratum reorders the Explanatory Notes for clauses 50, 51 and 52 in order to achieve alignment with the Bill.

Notes on Provisions

On pages 36 and 37 of the Explanatory Notes, replace the notes on clauses 50, 51 and 52 with the following:

“Clause 50 amends section 141D(1)(c) to provide that a person who is performing a risk-assessed role for a licensed care service must notify the nominee for the licensee if there is a change to the person’s personal history.

Clause 51 defines “relevant person” for the purposes of section 141H, to capture persons directly managing a licensed care service or persons performing risk-assessed roles for a licensed care service.

Clause 52 makes a drafting amendment to replace the heading of Chapter 4, Part 2, Division 7.”
