Erratum to Explanatory Notes

Title of the Bill

Education Legislation Amendment Bill 2013

Reason for Erratum

On 16 April 2013, the Education Legislation Bill 2013 (the Bill) was introduced to Parliament. The Bill was subsequently referred to the Education and Innovation Committee (the Committee) with a report back date of 16 July 2013.

On 16 July 2013, the Committee tabled its report (No.16) in relation to the Bill (the Report). Recommendation 5 of the Report was that minor typographical errors made in the Explanatory Notes be corrected. The Erratum corrects typographical errors in the Explanatory Notes.

Notes on provisions

On page 1 of the Explanatory Notes under the heading “*Recognise Prep as first year of schooling*” omit the words “state school” from the sixth line of the first paragraph.

On page 2 of the Explanatory Notes under the heading “*Cancel enrolment of international students for non-payment of tuition fees*” replace the word ‘charges’ with ‘charged’ in the second last bullet point.

On page 5 of the Explanatory Notes under the heading “*Cancel enrolment of international students for non-payment of tuition fees*” insert the word ‘than’ in the last sentence of the second paragraph before the words ‘requiring amendment in legislation’.

On page 16 of the Explanatory Notes after the second paragraph:

- item (a) omit ‘ma’ and insert the words ‘may be appointed for the longer term; and’.
- Item (b) omit; and
- Item (c) renumber as item (b).
