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(i) the contract price for the work or, if the work involves more than 1 contract, the total of the contract prices; or	1 2
(ii) if there is no contract price—the cost of the work as decided by the Board.	3 4
‘(2) The value under subsection (1)(a) of the part of the work carried out personally by the individual is—	5 6
(a) the percentage prescribed by regulation of the cost of the work; or	7
(b) if the individual can establish, to the satisfaction of the Board, a higher value for the part of the work carried out personally by the individual—that value.	8 9 10
‘(3) Despite subsection (1)(b)(i), if the Board is satisfied that the contract price for carrying out building and construction work is not an accurate estimate of the cost of the work, the cost may be decided by the Board.	11 12 13

(a) if an application is made to a local authority under the <i>Building Act 1975</i> for approval of the work—the person who makes the application; or	16 17 18
(b) in any other case—the person for whom the work is to be done.	19
‘When levy is payable	20
‘65B.(1) Levy for building and construction work to be carried out by a person (other than a government entity) must be paid—	21 22
(a) before application is made to a local authority under the <i>Building Act 1975</i> for approval of the work; or	23 24
(b) if application is not made under that Act for approval of the work—before the work is started or, if the Board allows a later time for payment, that time.	25 26 27
‘(2) Levy for building and construction work to be carried out by a	28

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government entity must be paid before the time, after the start of the work,
decided by the Board. 1

‘Government entity to notify of building and construction work 3

‘65C.(1) A government entity must notify the Board of building and
construction work the entity carries out, or causes to be carried out, within
3 months of the start of the work. 4

‘(2) Subsection (1) applies only if the cost of the work is not less than the
cost prescribed by regulation. 7

‘(3) Subsection (1) is in addition to section 70(2). 9

‘Duty of local authority to sight approved form 10

‘65D.(1) A local authority may accept an application under the *Building
Act 1975* for the approval of building and construction work only if the local
authority has seen an approved form issued by the Board signifying, for the
work— 11

(a) payment of levy; or 15

(b) payment of the first instalment of levy; or 16

(c) an exemption from payment of levy; or 17

(d) an exemption from immediate payment of levy. 18

‘(2) A local authority is entitled to be paid remuneration by the Board for
carrying out its duty under this section at the rate prescribed by regulation.’. 19
