<b>‘Retail shop lease core trading hours unaffected by s 51</b>	20
<b>‘52.</b> Section 51 does not apply so as to amend the meaning of the allowable trading hours for the definition <b>“core trading hours”</b> in the <i>Retail Shop Leases Act 1994</i> , section 51. <sup>3</sup>	21 22 23
