- ‘(4A) Subsections (3) and (4), other than the requirement to  
consider relevant circumstances under subsection (4)(c), do  
not apply if the chief executive is satisfied it is no longer  
possible to prevent or control the spread of the quarantine area  
pest in Queensland. 1

- ‘(4B) If all of Queensland is the subject of a pest quarantine area for  
any pest, an approved plant declaration may be made even if  
the planting or cultivating of an approved plant variety under  
the declaration may spread the pest to a crop plant within the  
relevant quarantine area.’. 6
