Amendments agreed to during Consideration

1 Clause 4 (Amendment of s 14 (Aborigines' and Torres Strait Islanders' rights to take fisheries resources etc.))

At page 5, lines 8 and 13, 'recreational'—

omit, insert—

'prescribed'.

2 Clause 4 (Amendment of s 14 (Aborigines' and Torres Strait Islanders' rights to take fisheries resources etc.))

At page 5, before line 22—

insert—

'prescribed fishing apparatus means—

- (a) fishing apparatus that is recreational fishing apparatus under a regulation under this Act; or
- (b) fishing apparatus that is used under Aboriginal tradition or Island custom, and prescribed specifically under a regulation for the purpose of this section.'

At page 5, line 28, 'prohibited.'—

omit, insert—

'prohibited.'?.
