Acquisition of Land Regulation 2014

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the Acquisition of Land Regulation 2014.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2014.

3 Fee—Act, s 9

The fee payable for an application under section 9 of the Act is—

- (a) if the application relates to only 1 parcel of land—\$179.70; or
- (b) if the application relates to more than 1 parcel of land—\$179.70 plus \$53.30 for each additional parcel of land.

4 Repeal

The Acquisition of Land Regulation 2003, SL No. 190 is repealed.
