Commonwealth Games Arrangements Regulation 2013

Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Commonwealth Games Arrangements Regulation 2013*.

Part 2 Protected images and protected references

2 ACGA images

For the Act, schedule 4, definition *ACGA image*, paragraph (a), each image in schedule 1 is an ACGA image.

3 CGF images

For the Act, schedule 4, definition *CGF image*, paragraph (a), each image in schedule 2 is a CGF image.

4 Games images

For the Act, schedule 4, definition *Games image*, paragraph (a), the following are Games images—

- (a) each image in schedule 3;
- (b) a substantial part of an image mentioned in paragraph (a), including, for example, the stylised representation of the phrase ‘Gold Coast 2018’, as it appears in the images shown in schedule 3, items 1 to 3.

5 Games references

- (1) For the Act, schedule 4, definition *Games reference*, paragraph (c), each expression mentioned in schedule 4 is a Games reference.
- (2) For the Act, section 53(2), definition *generic Games reference*, paragraph (b), a Games reference under subsection (1) is a generic Games reference.




