Further Education and Training (Training Ombudsman) and Another Act Amendment Act 2016

General Outline

Authorising law

Section 2 of the Further Education and Training (Training Ombudsman) and Another Act Amendment Act 2016 (the Act) provides that the Act will commence on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Policy objectives and the reasons for them

The objective of the Proclamation is to commence the Act on 22 April 2016. The Act amends the *Further Education and Training Act 2014* and the *Public Service Act 2008* by inserting provisions that:

- establish the training ombudsman as an independent statutory position appointed by the Governor in Council;
- maintain the integrity and independence of the training ombudsman; and
- establish the office of the training ombudsman as a public service office to support the training ombudsman.

Achievement of policy objectives

The policy objectives of the Act will be achieved by commencement of these provisions.

Consistency with policy objectives of authorising law

The Proclamation is consistent with the objectives of the Act.

Inconsistency with policy objectives of other legislation

The Proclamation is not inconsistent with any policy objectives of other legislation.

Alternative ways of achieving policy objectives

There are no alternative means of achieving the purpose of the Proclamation.

Benefits and costs of implementation

The commencement of the Act by Proclamation will not result in any additional costs to Government.

Consistency with fundamental legislative principles

The Proclamation raises no issues with regard to fundamental legislative principles.

Consultation

No consultation external to government occurred in relation to the commencement of the Act by Proclamation.
