

Proclamation – Personalised Transport Ombudsman Act 2019

Human Rights Certificate

Prepared in accordance with Part 3 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019* (HRA), I, Mark Bailey MP, Minister for Transport and Main Roads provide this human rights certificate with respect to the *Proclamation – Personalised Transport Ombudsman Act 2019* (Proclamation) made under the *Personalised Transport Ombudsman Act 2019* (PTO Act).

In my opinion, the Proclamation, as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the HRA. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The purpose of the Proclamation is to fix 9 March 2020 for the commencement of certain provisions in the PTO Act that are not in force.

Human Rights Issues

The Proclamation does not affect or engage a human right.

Conclusion

I consider that the Proclamation is compatible with the HRA because it does not raise a human rights issue.
