

# Proclamation – Resources Safety and Health Queensland Act 2020

## Human Rights Certificate

### Prepared in accordance with Part 3 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, Dr Anthony Lynham, Minister for Natural Resources, Mines and Energy provide this human rights certificate with respect to the *Proclamation – Resources Safety and Health Queensland Act 2020* (the Proclamation) made under the *Resources Safety and Health Queensland Act 2020*.

In my opinion, the Proclamation, as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

### Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The purpose of the Proclamation is to fix 1 July 2020 for the commencement of the provisions in the *Resources Safety and Health Queensland Act 2020* that are not in force.

### Human Rights Issues

#### Human rights relevant to the subordinate legislation (Part 2, Division 2 and 3 *Human Rights Act 2019*)

The Proclamation does not affect or engage a human right.

### Conclusion

I consider that the Proclamation is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019* because it does not raise any human rights issues.
