Proclamation to commence remaining provisions of the *Inspector of Detention Services Act 2022*

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, the Honourable Shannon Fentiman MP, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice, Minister for Women and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence, provide this human rights certificate with respect to the Proclamation to commence the provisions of the *Inspector of Detention Services Act 2022* that are not in force, on 1 July 2023.

In my opinion, the Proclamation, as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The Proclamation fixes 1 July 2023 as the day for the commencement of the provisions of the *Inspector of Detention Services Act 2022* that are not in force.

Human Rights Issues

There are no human rights relevant to the Proclamation.

Conclusion

I consider that the Proclamation is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019* because it does not raise any human rights issues.
