Government Owned Corporations Regulation 2024

Human Rights Certificate

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, the Honourable Cameron Dick MP, Deputy Premier, Treasurer and Minister for Trade and Investment provide this human rights certificate with respect to the *Government Owned Corporations Regulation 2024* (the Regulation) made under the *Government Owned Corporations Act 1993*.

In my opinion, the Regulation, as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The Government Owned Corporations Regulation 2014 (2014 Regulation) expires on 1 September 2024. The Regulation remakes the 2014 Regulation with amendments to account for developments and changes since the 2014 Regulation was made.

The 2024 Regulation supports the Government Owned Corporations Act 1993 (GOC Act) by:

- declaring the entities that are government owned corporations (GOCs); and
- prescribing financial accountability requirements for GOCs for the purposes of the *Financial Accountability Act 2009* and the *Financial and Performance Management Standard 2019*.

Human Rights Issues

The Regulation does not affect or engage human rights.

Conclusion

I consider that the Regulation is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019*.
