

Government Owned Corporations Regulation 2024

Human Rights Certificate

Prepared in accordance with Part 3 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*

In accordance with section 41 of the *Human Rights Act 2019*, I, the Honourable Cameron Dick MP, Deputy Premier, Treasurer and Minister for Trade and Investment provide this human rights certificate with respect to the *Government Owned Corporations Regulation 2024* (the Regulation) made under the *Government Owned Corporations Act 1993*.

In my opinion, the Regulation, as tabled in the Legislative Assembly, is compatible with the human rights protected by the *Human Rights Act 2019*. I base my opinion on the reasons outlined in this statement.

Overview of the Subordinate Legislation

The *Government Owned Corporations Regulation 2014* (2014 Regulation) expires on 1 September 2024. The Regulation remakes the 2014 Regulation with amendments to account for developments and changes since the 2014 Regulation was made.

The 2024 Regulation supports the *Government Owned Corporations Act 1993* (GOC Act) by:

- declaring the entities that are government owned corporations (GOCs); and
- prescribing financial accountability requirements for GOCs for the purposes of the *Financial Accountability Act 2009* and the *Financial and Performance Management Standard 2019*.

Human Rights Issues

The Regulation does not affect or engage human rights.

Conclusion

I consider that the Regulation is compatible with the *Human Rights Act 2019*.
