Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Building (Swimming Pool Safety—CPR Signs) Amendment Regulation 2016*.

2 Commencement

Part 3 commences on 1 January 2017.

3 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Building Regulation 2006*.

Part 2 Amendment to commence on notification

4 Amendment of s 13A (Resuscitation sign requirements and display)

Section 13A(2)(e)—

omit, insert—

- (e) show information about the procedures for providing first aid, including performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation in either of the following ways—
 - (i) in the way stated in the document called ‘Guideline 7—cardiopulmonary resuscitation’ published by the Australian Resuscitation Council in February 2006;
 - (ii) in the way stated in the document called ‘ANZCOR guideline 8—Cardiopulmonary resuscitation’

67 Resuscitation signs for particular regulated pools

- (1) This section applies for a regulated pool if, immediately before the commencement, a resuscitation sign that complied with former section 13A(2)(e) was displayed for the pool.
- (2) Former section 13A(2)(e) continues to apply until the sign becomes illegible.
- (3) In this section—

former section 13A(2)(e) means section 13A(2)(e) as in force immediately before the commencement.

resuscitation sign see section 13A(4).
