1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Nature Conservation (Protected Areas Management) (Cooroibah Conservation Park) Amendment Regulation 2017*.

2 Regulation amended

This regulation amends the *Nature Conservation (Protected Areas Management) Regulation 2006*.

3 Amendment of sch 1 (Trustees of conservation parks)

Cooroibah Conservation Park	Noosa Shire Council	<p>The powers of the chief executive under this regulation or the Administration Regulation other than the power to—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) charge a fee for entry to the park; or (b) grant any of the following— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) a permit to take, use, keep or interfere with cultural or natural resources; (ii) an apiary permit; (iii) an Aboriginal tradition authority or Island custom authority; (iv) a commercial activity permit or special activity permit; (v) an organised event permit; (vi) a stock grazing permit, stock mustering permit or travelling stock permit; or (c) enter into a commercial activity agreement; or (d) give permission to conduct a controlling activity; or (e) erect or display a regulatory notice; or (f) approve— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) the lighting of a fire; or (ii) the use of a herbicide or pesticide; or (iii) the possession or use of an appliance; or (g) erect a sign or place a marking regulating the use of a vehicle, boat or recreational craft, or a type of vehicle, boat or recreational craft; or (h) release, sell or dispose of a seized thing; or (i) declare a restricted access area.
