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**1 Short title**

This notice may be cited as the *Superannuation (State Public Sector) Amendment Notice 2023*.

**2 Commencement**

This notice commences on 1 April 2023.

**3 Notice amended**

This notice amends the *Superannuation (State Public Sector) Notice 2021*.
