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1 Short title

This management plan may be cited as the *Wet Tropics (Consequential Amendments) Amendment Management Plan 2023*.

Note—

Under the intergovernmental agreement the primary goal is identified as providing for the implementation of Australia’s international duty for the protection, conservation, presentation, rehabilitation and transmission to future generations, of the wet tropics area.

State government entity means a government entity under the *Public Sector Act 2022*, section 276, but does not include a government owned corporation.
