Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *TAFE Queensland Regulation 2024*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2024.

Part 2 Dual sector entities

3 Dual sector entity—Act, s 57B

For section 57B(1) of the Act, the Central Queensland University established under the *Central Queensland University Act 1998*, section 4 is prescribed.

4 Prescribed amount—Act, s 57O

For section 57O(1)(c) of the Act, the amount prescribed is \$3,000,000.

Part 3 Savings provision

5 Saving of operation of particular provisions of expired regulation

- (1) Sections 29 and 42 of the expired regulation are declared to be laws to which the *Acts Interpretation Act 1954*, section 20A applies.
- (2) In this section—

expired regulation means the expired *TAFE Queensland Regulation 2013* as in force before the commencement.
