# Professional Standards (Australian Property Institute Valuers Limited Scheme) Notice 2016

## 1 Short title

This notice may be cited as the *Professional Standards (Australian Property Institute Valuers Limited Scheme) Notice 2016*.

## 2 Commencement

Section 4 commences on 1 September 2016.

## 3 Approval of interstate scheme—Act, s 14(1)

The Australian Property Institute Valuers Limited Scheme is an interstate scheme that has been approved by the appropriate council for New South Wales.
