under its control, a local government may inform itself of the
local community’s views about adding fluorine to the water
supply in any way it considers appropriate, including, for
example—

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(a) by considering its councillors’ views about adding
fluorine to the water supply; or

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(b) by surveying persons who use water from the water
supply; or
